

## WELCOME


**Welcome** to this the very first edition of the Totaleigh Music Newsletter which as to yet I am not sure will become a monthly or termly publication....watch this space, I guess!

### FASCINATING MUSICAL FACT

Musical Education Leads to Better Exam Scores. Studying music is an actual workout for your brain. Learning an instrument has been proven to help students in myriad ways from mastery of memorisation, pattern recognition and emotional development. Students who have experience with music performance or taking music appreciation courses score higher on the SAT(Scholastic Aptitude Test). A report indicated that they score, on average, 63 points higher on verbal and 44 points higher on math.

I played the violin many years ago as a child. Life took over, work and being a busy Mum, I stopped playing. Moving to Tywyn a few years ago and I enquired about lessons to try to get back playing, but was told that there were no string teachers in the area. A few years passed by and I was a member of a choir, but was not able to take up the violin again.

when I heard that Leigh was teaching in Tywyn, I enquired about Banjo lessons for my husband. I was then delighted, if very rusty and apprehensive, to find out Leigh would give me violin lessons too. My lessons were very enjoyable, I progressed quickly and I also took up the treble recorder. Deciding I needed to refresh my theory knowledge I started music theory lessons, progressing through the grades with Leigh's help. As I am one of the more senior students, I couldn't believe that I was able to achieve my grade 5 (with distinction) after only 2 years, a tribute to Leigh's tuition. During this time I really got hooked and have developed into a multi-instrumentalist. Since last Christmas I have started learning the following instruments; Soprano recorder, Guitar, Clarinet, Piano, Ukulele, Banjolele, Glockenspiel, Flute, Soprano Saxophone. I am at varying levels, with each instrument. Taking up the clarinet last Christmas, (resulting in a panic zoom lesson Boxing day, as I couldn't even blow the Clarinet) I have just passed my grade 2. I am working towards grade 5 on the violin and treble recorder. On the other instruments I am mostly beginner level.

Working as a Community Nurse my music is a way of destressing after a busy day. Each instrument gives me a different feeling. Some exhilarating, others relaxing, some more challenging than others. I am thoroughly enjoying the journey. I hope to keep progressing, taking grades along the way to mark the level I manage to achieve. I never planned or even dreamt that I would Learning so many instruments. Being part of the Totaleigh Music school with Leigh has enriched my life and I hope eventually to able to pass on my knowledge to others and teach part time.
