November 2020 and things began to move on and the first lesson was booked. Panic time! I got the guitar out but had forgotten most of what I had learned in the past. Out came 'The Guitarists Way Book 1'. I was starting over again. It was a bit like riding a bike and the basics soon came back as did the camaraderie.

Soon after, my company closed the Stafford office and the whole workforce began working from home on a permanent basis. One of the advantages of this was that I have had more time to practice - half an hour in the morning and another during my lunch break. It's been a great way to switch off from "work life".


The weekly zoom guitar lesson with Leigh soon became the "Highlight of the Week". I love the lessons and the banter that we have.

So far, I haven't ventured beyond the guitar or into the world of Grades (even though Leigh is steering me that way). I lack confidence when playing in front of anyone else but am thoroughly looking forward to joining the Fretted String Orchestra and meeting fellow students.


Can't recommend Leigh enough if you want a music teacher! She puts you at ease and is very encouraging. The zoom lessons have been easy going too.

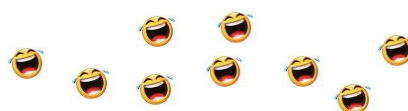

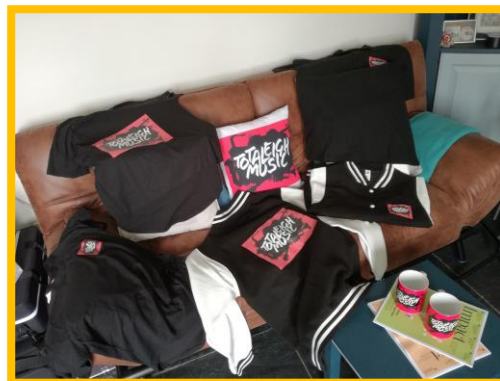
